My youngest son Henry was born in 2002 with a complex heart condition. He had eight open heart surgeries and a heart transplant by the age of five. We're lucky that Henry is 17 and healthy today, but he requires life-saving, anti-rejection medications, and if we didn't have access to Medicaid, it would bankrupt my family.

Right now, there are nearly 200,000 Oklahomans who still don't have that same access to care. They earn too much to qualify for Medicaid and not enough to be able to afford health insurance. These families have to decide whether to seek medical care for their loved ones or put food on the table.

With Medicaid expansion, we can do better for Oklahoma families and improve the economy in our local communities. It's a win-win solution, and it's time to get this done.
