FAQ ABOUT SIGNATURE GATHERING

Question: Where and when can I turn my signature sheets in and get more petitions?

Answer: For now, the campaign has weekly office hours for petition turn-in and notarization, check-out, and signature collection training on Mondays from 11 AM to 3 PM at the following locations in Tulsa and Oklahoma City:
