816 Likely 2020 General Election Voters - Statewide

**Q1. Regardless of what you think of the political parties, which party are you registered to vote with?**

- 31% The Democratic party
- 58 The Republican party
- 9 Independent
- 1 Some other political party

**Q2. In November, there will be an election for President and other important offices. Do you plan to vote in this election?**

- 97% Yes, will definitely vote
- 2 Yes, will probably vote but there is a chance I might not
- 1 Maybe, 50-50. I might vote or I might not

**Q3. Turning to some issues... Do you support or oppose expanding Oklahoma's Medicaid program to people whose incomes are less than seventeen thousand dollars a year if they are single and twenty-three thousand dollars a year for a family of two?**

- 38% Strongly support
- 29 Somewhat support
- 10 Somewhat oppose
- 13 Strongly oppose
- 10 Not sure

**Q4. How concerned are you that rural hospitals in Oklahoma face financial hardship and could close if the state does not expand the Medicaid program?**

- 53% Very concerned
- 28 Somewhat concerned
- 10 Not too concerned

**Methodology** Polling was conducted online from February 22-23, 2020 using its Dynamic Online Sampling technology to attain a sample reflective of likely 2020 general election voters. It has a margin of error of 3.7 percentage points.
